Achievement Levels are used across Nova Scotia to communicate information about student learning and/or skill development. Achievement Levels focus on:

- the depth of knowledge and understanding of an outcome
- the extent of the application of the outcome



4	<u>In-depth</u> knowledge and understanding of content and concepts. Able to extend the application of related skills.
3+	Competent +
3	<u>Competent</u> knowledge and understanding of content and concepts. Appropriate application of the related skills.
2+	Developing +
2	<u>Developing</u> knowledge and understanding of content and concepts. Developing in the application of the related skills.
1+	Limited +
1	<u>Limited</u> knowledge and understanding of content and concepts. Limited application of related skills.
